Headteacher Message

Dear parents and carers

No doubt you will be aware of the WorthLess campaign Headteachers and Governing Bodies of West Sussex schools have been waging for some time now. As media coverage gathers pace it is clear to see that schools throughout England are expressing their deep misgivings about the government's newly proposed Fair Funding formula, which in reality is anything but fair. Based on this newly proposed formula we have calculated that Southway would benefit to the tune of approximately £1000. However, this is in reality a funding cut given the rise in inflation and future rise in basic costs. Having spoken to Headteachers across Burgess Hill and beyond, some schools are in fact going to be significantly worse off and are facing a genuine crisis. What might this mean in reality? In effect myself and the governing body of our school will have no choice but to make choices about what we can offer for our children and what we can't. This is all set within increased expectations from parents and from services about what schools can deliver. Cuts to health, social care and children's mental health services has meant that schools have been pressured to take on these roles and to offer access to services to support families and children in crisis when we are only funded to fulfil our duties of education. This is, of course completely unsustainable. For the past three and a half years we have been able to improve the school building, employ extra support staff and invest in our children's future. This has now come to a grinding halt and I am deeply concerned about what happens next. This week you will have received a copy of a letter all West Sussex Headteachers have sent to their local MP expressing their concerns and urging them to take immediate action. I would urge you to do the same before it is too late. Please join me in expressing this message loud and clear to those who have the power to give us the resources to ensure a world-class education system that our children deserve.
