Headteacher Message

Dear parents and carers

It is brilliant to have the pool open this term and the children have been having a great time all week. A big thank you to Mr Kirby for doing such a sterling job in preparing it. I have never seen it cleaner and more cared for; in fact we had a spot check from an inspector who described our pool as the cleanest and best maintained they had ever seen! We have now introduced a swimming certificate scheme for all children (based on ASA guidance) and over the next few weeks your child should be coming home, the proud owner of at least one if not more!

On a separate note I would like to remind all parents that either drop off or pick up their children in cars that we strongly urge you to walk down Southway and use the parking spaces available at The Weald and St Edwards Church.
