Headteacher Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

Last week we had a full day's visit from two senior Local Authority advisers. Their role was to evaluate our school's quality of teaching, the breadth of our curriculum and the effectiveness of our leadership and management. The visit involved wide ranging discussions with myself, senior leaders, various staff members and children as well as spending a lot of time in classes observing our teaching practice. We received the final report this week and I have sent out a copy to you for your information. You will see that it is wholly positive and we are delighted that yet again our work is recognised by West Sussex. Indeed one of the advisers described Southway as 'unique' in offering such a broad and exciting curriculum whilst maintaining such high standards and expectations of children. Teaching and learning was described as 'outstanding', which is a term principally used by Ofsted and not one I feel is useful. I prefer to think of Southway as 'great' and our aim is to do the very best we can as often as we can, despite the significant pressures brought to bear on schools by government. This week I spent time in classrooms talking to children about their views on various subjects, including maths. I was overwhelmed by the positive responses I received. One of our lovely year 3 girls told me that she 'loved maths because it gave her an opportunity to learn things and it was fun.' We will continue on our path of improvement and we appreciate the support you provide us with.


