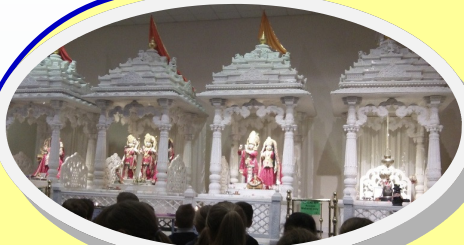

"As the team walked in we had mixed emotions but once we saw the layout we weren't as nervous as we were before we arrived."

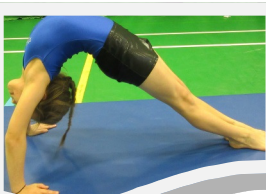
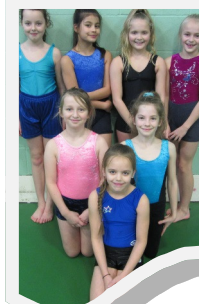
At first the music in the background was a bit off-putting but when we started we hardly noticed it was playing."
