How we govern



Composition of the Governing Body (GB)

- GB includes parents, senior leaders, teachers, community and local authority representatives
- Structure of the GB is reviewed and agreed annually
- Key posts are elected annually (ie. Chair, Vice Chairs)

Governance processes/effectiveness

- We have a detailed Governance induction pack which contains all relevant documents/guidance and training requirements and governors use this in performing their roles
- We govern the school through three working committees:
 1. **Full Governing Body** (FGB) – focuses on policies, statutory duties and governance structures
 2. **Teaching, Learning and Staffing** (TLS) – focuses on the quality of teaching and pupils progress, achievements and outcomes
 3. **Finance and Premises** (F&P) – focuses on financial management, premises priorities and health and safety
- School Development and Improvement Plan (SDIP) is monitored and reviewed each term by senior school leaders and nominated governors who then report to the GB in the appropriate committee.

The role of the GB is to provide strategic management and to act as a ‘critical friend’, supporting the work of the headteacher and all staff

Chair of Finance and Premises	<i>Kieron Woodland</i>	Oversee the financial management, controls and priorities for the school
SEND Governor	<i>Kieron Woodland</i>	Work alongside the SENDco to ensure the needs of all SEND children are met
Safeguarding governor	<i>Peter Izard</i>	To ensure the school is compliant with all key legislation
Complaints Governor	<i>Stephen Adams</i>	To follow school policy if a formal complaint against the school is lodged
Training governor	<i>Helen Lewis</i>	To ensure all governors have undertaken appropriate training to fulfil their roles
Policies governor	<i>Helen Lewis</i>	To ensure all school policies are updated
Health and Safety governor	<i>Stephen Adams</i>	To ensure the school is compliant with all H & S legislation
Headteacher Performance Management	<i>Peter Izard</i>	To independently assess Headteacher performance
