Y5 SEVEN SISTERS COUNTRY PARK – TUESDAY 4th JUNE 2024

As part of our Seas, Storms and Survival summer learning journey, we plan to visit Seven Sisters Country Park on Tuesday 4th June 2024. This exciting trip provides children with an invaluable opportunity to apply skills learnt in the geography classroom to outdoor field exercises, while exploring one of Sussex's most famous natural landscapes.

- We will leave at **8:45** and return by **3:00pm**
- Children will need to wear **school t-shirt & jumper, jogging bottoms/leggings and comfortable walking shoes/trainers that may get muddy and wet.**
- They will also need to bring **an additional pair of comfortable trainers (that may get muddy) in a plastic bag, a waterproof jacket a packed lunch in a disposable bag and a full water bottle**
- If your child has free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them on the day. This will need to be ordered via Parent Pay order **by Thursday 23rd May**: select "Chartwells trip lunch - FREE SCHOOL MEALS ONLY". If a lunch is not booked, your child will need to bring in their own packed lunch as we no longer have spares available.
- You are invited to contribute **£12.00** to cover the cost of the coach, activities and insurance.

Although this contribution is voluntary, it is probable the visit could not take place without all able parents willingly contributing. We appreciate that some families might find it difficult to contribute all of the suggested sum. If so, please do not hesitate to contact our Headteacher or School Business Manager to discuss in confidence whether suitable arrangements can be made to cover the cost of participation.
