Yesterday I had the privilege of attending the annual Brighton College Education Conference with our Chair of Governors, Peter Izard. This was an opportunity to listen to a range of well respected speakers on a variety of education related topics. The list included Peter Tatchell (a human rights campaigner), Andreas Schiller (an internationally respected adviser on government education policy and the designer of the PISA tests used to rank OECD countries in terms of educational performance) and the former MP Alan Johnson (Labour Home Secretary under Tony Blair). Whilst I enjoyed listening to them all I was most captivated by Alan who spoke eloquently about his humble background (although grinding poverty would best describe it) and his rise to one of the most preeminent political positions in the country. His story is one of relentless energy and a refusal to allow his social background to prevent him from fulfilling any ambition he may have had. In his particular case his was a desire to make the world a better place for everyone and not just the few. His stories were both insightful, warm and humorous and I am now in the process of reading the first of his memoirs, all with the titles of well known Beatles songs. I thoroughly recommend them.
