
## **Invaders & Raiders!**

Stepping back in time to 1939, children experienced first-hand the challenges, emotions and excitement of life as an evacuee in our immersive Evacuation Day role play. On Make Do and Mend Day, Year 5 evacuees then embraced the challenge of wartime rationing as they fashioned dolly peg dolls, mastered finger knitting and learned to darn socks. Further deepening their knowledge and understanding of the home front, children explored the labyrinthine coastal defences of Newhaven Fort, where they enjoyed a unique air raid experience and relished handling original wartime artefacts.








## **Blitzed Art**


Inspired by Henry Moore, Year 5 created chalk and charcoal sketches of life in a London Underground air raid shelter at the height of the Blitz.











## Year 6 excellent wo








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### **News and notices**
