Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.

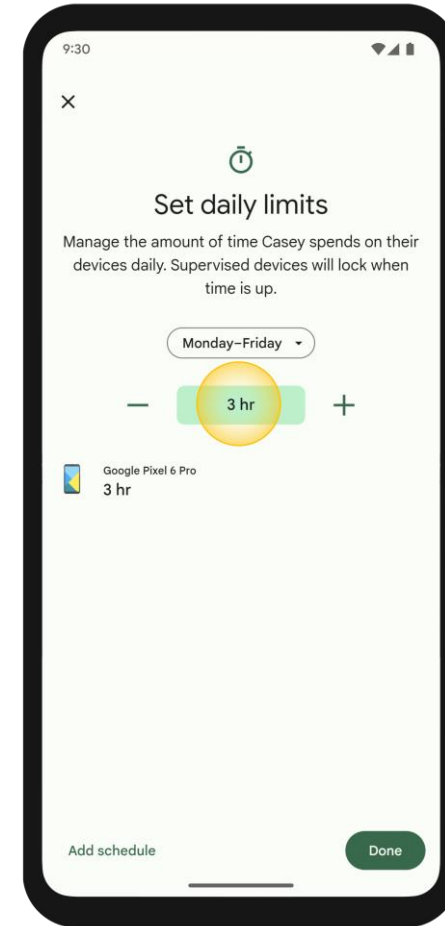
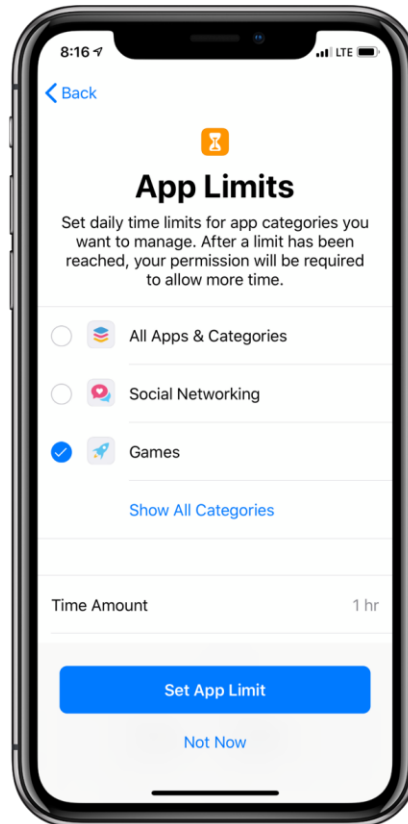
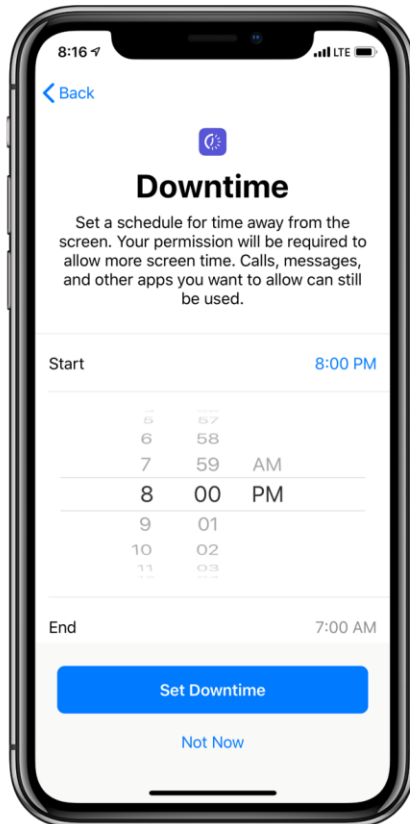
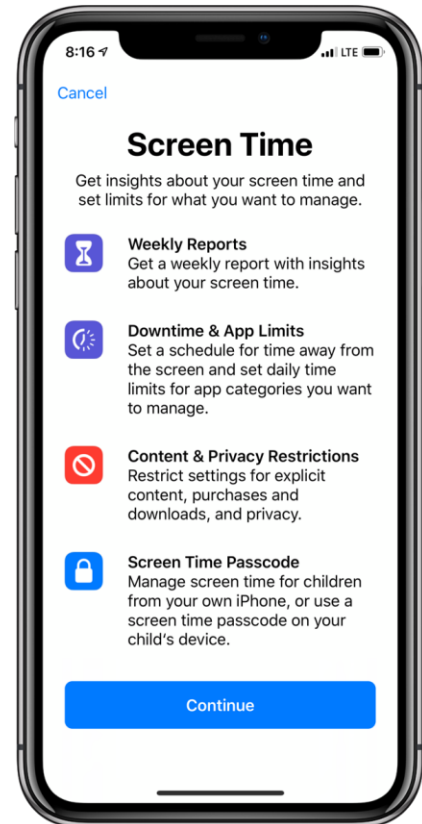

Home Learning Expectations

- Set and due on Wednesdays
- Weekly times tables and spellings (15 mins of each)
- Times tables: Using children's Times Table Rockstars account (logins stuck into reading record)
- Spellings: Using children's Spelling Shed account (logins in reading record)
- Teachers can then check amount of time spent on each and the activities completed.



Live demo

- Times tables: Using children's Times Table Rockstars account (logins stuck into reading record)
- Teachers are able to check how long children spend practising times tables using TTR. The expectation is 15 minutes across the week. This resets every Wednesday.



Anton.app

- This is an additional resource that children can access at home (logins in reading record).
- It is fantastic for recapping any gaps children may have or for some pre-teaching.



Reading Expectations

- Children should read at home as often as possible:
 - At least 3 times per week, on different days
 - Borrowing books - come in every day in school bags, we will provide a zippy wallet to keep them in.
- Reading records checked weekly (given days) – please bring in every day
- Please can a child/adult make a comment in reading record.

Reading Every Day Goes a Very Long Way

Student A Reads

- 20 minutes per day
- 3,600 minutes per school year
- 1,800,000 words per year



Student B Reads

- 5 minutes per day
- 900 minutes per school year
- 282,000 words per year



Student C Reads

- 1 minute per day
- 180 minutes per school year
- 8,000 words per year
