## **Home Learning**

- Weekly homework will rotate between GPS, maths and reading tasks.
- Homework will be set on a <u>Wednesday</u> and due back in on the following <u>Wednesday</u>, when we will mark it.
- Homework should be completed in their homework book and we expect to see all their workings for maths.
- Homework will be differentiated and children will often get to choose their level of difficulty for homework.
- Please keep in touch if there are any issues with homework. All children are aware that if they do not understand something, they can ask their teacher at school prior to the hand in day (Wednesday).



## Home Learning Reading Journals

- Children should read at home as often as possible.
- They should record their reading in their Home Reading Journals, 3 times a week as a minimum (one of these will be completed in school).
- Adults do not need to write in their children's reading journals in Year 4.
- Reading journals should be in bags everyday, but are marked on a <u>Friday</u>.



## **Spellings**

- Spellings learnt in class will also be stuck into homework books for the children to take home and learn. In week 1 and 2, they will have spellings to learn. In week 3, they will not as we will be testing the week 1 and 2 spellings that week. We would like for children to write their spellings into sentences, to help them to remember them.
- Please encourage your child to use their spelling words in conversation, as well as their writing.



## **Times Tables**

- In June, children will have to sit the Year 4 multiplication check. This is done in school and is a similar format to Times Tables Rockstars.
- We expect children to be engaging with Times Tables
   Rockstars weekly in order to develop their fluency and
   accuracy. Little and often is the key, so if children have been
   on for a total of 25 minutes over a week, they will earn an
   extra 5 minutes break.
- We also complete weekly times tables practice as part of maths learning.
