

## WHAT WILL WE BE DOING IN EACH SUBJECT?

**ENGLISH:** we will learn how to writes stories, letters, instructions and persuasive texts. We will also create and perform poetry.

MATHS: we will exploring place value and apply our formal methods to solve problems involving the 4 operations.

**GEOGRAPHY:** we will conduct fieldwork in the local area, map the physical and human features of Burgess Hill, learn about habitats around the world, develop atlas skills and consider how we can save and preserve endangered habitats.

**SCIENCE:** we will be growing plants, investigating animals' habitats and learning how to classify these animals.

**PSHCE:** we will be focusing on new beginnings and smooth transitions to ensure children settle happily into Southway. Additional crosscurricular lessons throughout the term will provide context and purpose to ensure all children have the best chance of enjoying a strong start.

**COMPUTING:** we will learn about internet safety as well as using the internet for research and using databases to organise information.

<u>PE:</u> will cover movement and shape in gymnastics as well as invasion games, including football.

ART and DT: we will experiment with collage, photography, cooking and puppet making.

FRENCH: we will learn key words and greetings.

MUSIC: we will appreciate and sing music from a variety of genres, play the glockenspiel and take recorder lessons.


