Curriculum Corner - Mathematics

Southway has been busy mathematically this term with lots of different activities taking place. As well as the normal lessons, the children took part in Maths Week last week which involved a Times Tables Rockstars 'battle' between all the classes in the school. We also carried out an investigation which made them think logically, hypothesise possible outcomes and even develop rules. During our Monday assembly the children were challenged to think of a job that does not involve maths to highlight it's importance and application to everyday life – as yet, no one has managed to tell me one!

We also held a parent workshop before half term that allowed us to demonstrate the strategies we teach the children to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication & division problems.
