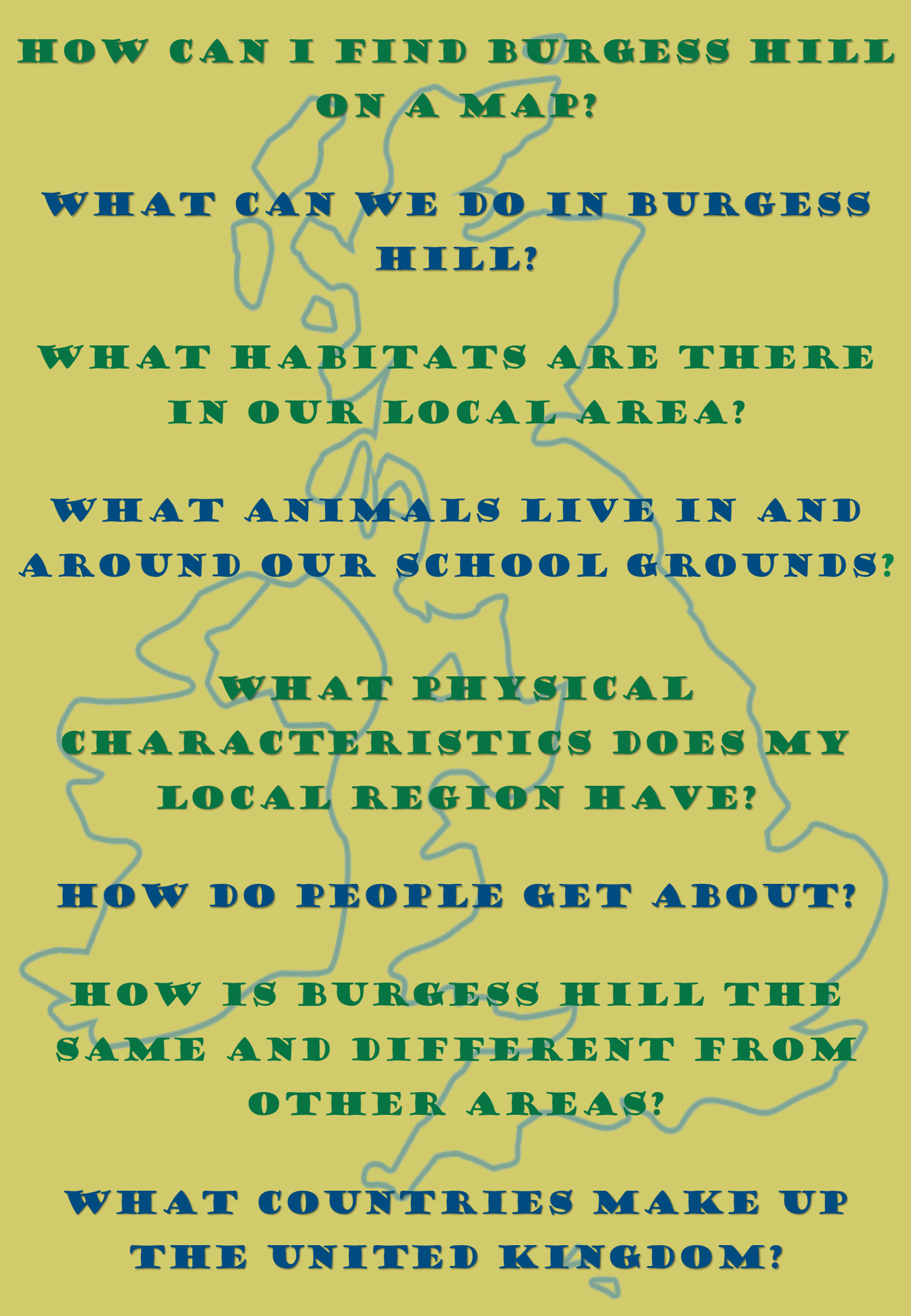

# WHAT WILL WE BE DOING IN EACH SUBJECT?

**ENGLISH:** we will learn how to write descriptions, postcards, and persuasive texts. We will also create and perform poetry.

**MATHS:** we will explore place value and apply our formal methods to solve problems involving the 4 operations.

**GEOGRAPHY:** we will conduct fieldwork in the local area, map the physical and human features of Burgess Hill, learn about habitats around the world, develop atlas skills and consider how we can save and preserve endangered habitats.

**SCIENCE:** we will be growing plants, investigating the requirements of plants for life and exploring the lifecycle of flowering plants.

**PSHE:** we will be focusing on new beginnings and smooth transitions to ensure children settle happily into Southway. Additional cross-curricular lessons throughout the term will provide context and purpose to ensure all children have the best chance of enjoying a strong start.

**COMPUTING:** we will explore and learn how to programme Microbits to perform different functions as well as developing an understanding of how computers work and how digital devices can be connected.

**PE:** will cover movement and shape in gymnastics as well as invasion games, including football.

**ART and DT:** we will experiment with charcoal, cooking gingerbread and puppet making.

**FRENCH:** we will learn greetings and key words to describe shape, size and colour.

**MUSIC:** we will appreciate and sing music from a variety of genres, play the glockenspiel and take recorder lessons.

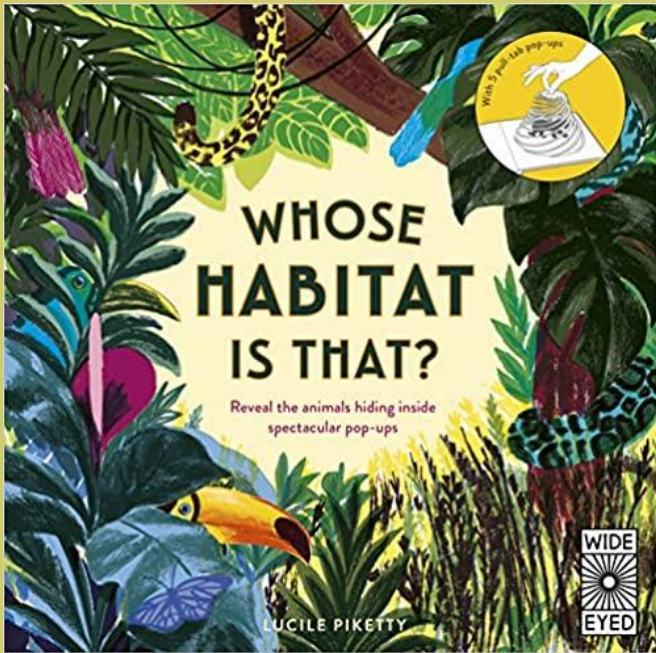
